FP7 SISTER project


Objectives:

- to improve the research environment of FMI
- to build a strong long-term collaboration with leading research and business organisations in EU and the SEE countries
- to make FMI a well-known research centre in SEE

Strategic framework for FMI in ICT

Vision:

- Faculty ICT community to become
- locally and internationally recognized in research, teaching and service
- recognized nationally for student excellence

Mission:

- provide a flexible, multi-disciplinary environment
- for high quality ICT research and education
- using innovation, latest technologies and world expertise





Strategic goals

- Quality of FMI education, training, information and research services to gain program competitiveness, high levels of achievement and a knowledgeable community
- Relevance of education and research services to the needs of Bulgarian society and economy
- Access for individuals of all ages to education, training and information services to develop their competences and to become globally competitive workers, responsible citizens, and lifelong learners
- Efficient operation and management of the education and research system and investments in student learning-centered ICT





Strategy measures

- Focus: financial issues, stakeholders, internal processes, and learning and growth of FMI
- Learning and growth measures
 - asses human and organisational capital
 - human resources growth, motivation of young people/PhD students for a research career
 - reward and remuneration initiatives, team building sessions, internal knowledge transfer, adoption of best academic culture practices, etc.





Main Achievements

- Shared view about current efforts in Bulgaria in the Software and Services (S&S) and Intelligent Content and Semantics (ICS) established
- Emphasis on Bulgarian NESSI platform and collaboration within European NESSI initiatives
- Enhanced collaboration with industry and other research organisations in Bulgaria and in Europe through launching of new projects and joint initiatives
- Strengthened human resources capacity through involvement of young researchers and regular research and training seminars in ICT and in interdisciplinary areas
- Improved research environment at FMI through establishment of 2 new research labs, PhD lab, first real digital repository in Bulgaria at FMI and provision of access to scientific libraries
- Higher visibility of FMI research in Bulgaria, SEE and Europe as a whole
- SISTER incubator of new projects






Sustainability of results
