Report on BulRMCNet Dissemination workshop

The dissemination on BulRMCNet activities was carried out at several events within the project and Research Mobility Centres (RMC) external activities:

Similarly to the Portal promotion, during the project implementation was decided not to arrange a special BulRMCNet dissemination workshop, but to include the network promotion in several events in the capital and at regional level, namely the three training seminars in Varna, Rousse and Stara Zagora and the conference on 'Researchers' Mobility and Career'.

The main dissemination events at regional level took place from 29 March to 5 April 2007 in the regional network nodes – on 29 March in Stara Zagora, on 4 April in Varna and on 5 April in Rousse. The seminars had a common part with speakers coming from all Bulgarian RMCs, and a regional part – with local lecturers invited by the RMCs, and a session devoted to FP7 program People. At all seminars were disseminated a number of BulRMCNet project and ERA MORE materials:

Within the main program of the seminars was included a presentation on the European strategy main instruments - ERA MORE and the European Research Mobility Portal (RMP), the Bulgarian Network of Research Mobility Centres (RMC) and the Bulgarian RMP. A presentation on the Maria Curie actions within FP7 was included in the program of all seminars. In addition, the RMC representatives had the opportunity to present to the audience the specific activities of their Centre, its situation within the university, its main tasks and activities.

In general, the seminars provided a forum at regional level for discussing mobility issues and the respective tools concerning researchers' career. The regional addition to the main program focused on topics of interest to the regional community and was aimed at supporting them in the provision of services and advise to mobile researchers.

Finally the impact at regional level could be seen in raising the awareness of the public in three directions:

- The importance of research human resources for building the European and the Bulgarian knowledge economy and society
- Bulgarian and Europe-wide initiatives related to researchers career, e.g. ERA MORE and the RMPs
- The career and job opportunities for young scientists in Europe under FP7
